The first of the Commission's additional monthly meetings focused on the Transportation Master Plan is next Thursday, February 1. This meeting will be a working session and any action to be taken will be at the regular Commission meetings. At this first meeting, the discussion will center on the organization of the Transportation Master Plan (through the Table of Contents), the Vision and Goals for the Master Plan, the Policy Element of the Master Plan and an introduction of the Modal Plans starting with the Pedestrian Element. The presentation will be brief to allow more time for discussion and dialogue.
